
Yearbook

A photo book

A memory book

A history book

People should be able to look back in 20 or 30 years and remember the blizzard that shut down schools across the nation.

A record and reference book

It's all too easy for a staff to want to only report the positive. Who were the players? What was the score?

A public-relations tool

A yearbook promotes your school to the public. For families moving in to a city and deciding on which school to send their kids to, they can look through a yearbook and see all that your school has to offer.



Business Idea: Digital Yearbooks

[1] At 15, Catherine Cook and her brother Dave, 17, were flipping through their high school yearbook. They saw the name of a girl they both knew but her picture looked nothing like her. 'These old yearbooks really sucked, they badly needed updating,' Catherine smiles. 'We thought it would be a great idea to put a yearbook online. Why not have a profile page that can list your TV interests, the music you like and your hobbies? Updating the page is your own responsibility.'

- [2] In 2005, the two convinced their older brother Geoff, a businessman, to invest \$250,000 and asked him to help them launch MyYearbook.com, a social-networking site.
- [3] Teenagers from all over the country came to the site. They were followed by investors and advertisers who very much wanted to reach the teen audience. But there were investors that wanted to move the company's headquarters to New York

(the Cooks wanted to stay put); they also wanted to have ads appear on users' personal profile pages (the Cooks didn't).

[4] It was a good thing the Cooks stuck to their vision. The business, now with 45 employees, has attracted advertisers such as Neutrogena, Disney and ABC. These are really big and important American companies. It has grown to 3 million members worldwide and rakes in annual sales in the 'seven figures', says Catherine. How to compete in an industry dominated by MySpace and Facebook? 'Our site is specifically for high school students, and we really listen to the suggestions of our members,' she says.

[5] The site is free and gives every student an online 'yearbook'. Students digitally sign each other's yearbooks and can vote for the classmate with the 'best eyes' or for the 'cutest couple', among other

categories. They can also share music, photos and videos. Students can 'flirt', 'battle' and 'secretly admire' one another with the click of a mouse. 'We take social games to a new level,' Dave said.

[6] While the Cooks don't want to discuss the value of their business, one MyYearbook investor (who agreed to speak only if unidentified) claims the Cooks' chunk is worth 'well over \$1 million.'

[7] 'We've had some offers from people who want to buy us out, a few pretty big ones,' Catherine says. 'And I've had lots of job offers for when I've graduated from college, but I'm not interested right now. I'm having too much fun working on the site.'
